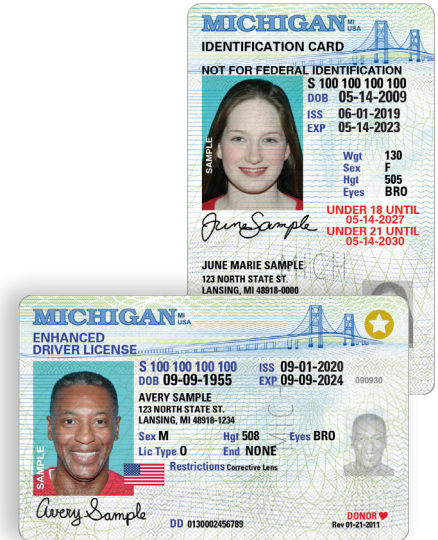


Michigan's transition to new driver's licenses and ID cards

Michigan's license design is being phased out

- Licenses are valid until their expiration date
- Licenses and IDs will be phased out of circulation by 2029
- State seal on the front is viewable under UV light source
- Cardholder's photo and birth date is viewable on back under UV light source
- Laser-perforated word "MICH" is viewable when held up to the light
- Optically variable image of a bridge and the word "Michigan" appears and disappears when viewed from different angles



New license and ID card higher security design features

- Variable laser perforation tied to cardholder data
- Optically variable image of THE GREAT LAKES
- Laser-engraved ghost image of the cardholder, variable data tactile date of birth and laser ablation

Michigan's enhanced license and ID

- Shares the basic design of the new standard license and ID card
- Features a U.S. flag near the cardholder portrait
