Who is eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program?

You are eligible if your household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

OR

If you (or someone in your household) participate in one of these programs:

- Medicaid
- WIC (Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children)
- SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), formerly known as Food Stamps
- SSI (Supplemental Security Income)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
- Free and reduced-price school meals
- Federal Pell Grant recipient in the current award year
