Agencies attending:

Financial Literacy

- **LSS** offers consumer credit counseling services, budget and debt management counseling, student loan debt repayment counseling, debt management plans, housing counseling and more!

Food Resources and more

- **Community Emergency Services** offers many services including Meals on Wheels for people and their pets, food home delivery, a Superfood Shelf, winter coats, household goods, a back-to-school backpack program, and transportation to food shelf visits. Limited financial supports may be available.

Healthcare

- **Hennepin Health** gives health care coverage to residents enrolled in a Minnesota health care program.
- **Minnesota Department of Health In-Home Covid Vaccine Program** offers COVID vaccines to Minnesotans in their home including people with disabilities, chronic health conditions, children, and caregivers.

Legal Aid

- **Minnesota Disability Law Center** helps individuals with disabilities with free civil legal issues that are related to their disabilities.

- **Metro Transit** offers a network of buses, light rail and commuter trains and resources for those who carpool, vanpool, walk or bike.
