PROJECT NAME: Rule 25 and/or Comprehensive Assessments to Incarcerated Men and Women

DETAILS: The Minnesota Department of Corrections, Reentry Services and Release Planning Section of the Health Services Unit, is requesting proposals for the purpose of providing Rule 25 and/or Comprehensive Assessments to incarcerated men and women nearing release in DOC facilities. This initiative will be a collaborative release planning effort with the DOC Case Management and Supervised Release Agents. Project goals are to increase appropriate access to post-release clinical SUD treatment needs and connection to those services in the community. This MOU is a mutual benefit, no cost project on behalf of the DOC; it does not include a budget, travel or any other reimbursable expenses.

Work is anticipated to start after March 6, 2019.
