

The Minnesota Evidence Based Practice (EBP) Advisory Committee Application

The Minnesota Evidence-Based Practices (EBP) Advisory Committee was initially formed in April of 2004 by request of the Minnesota Commissioner of Corrections. The essential purpose of the EBP Advisory Committee is to support and strengthen the use of evidence-based practices throughout Minnesota's correctional delivery systems, both in the institutions and in the field of probation and parole. The purpose of this group is to provide leadership, support, consultation and recommendations on the applicability, implementation and desired outcomes of EBP. In addition, the advisory committee will promote the values, guide sustainability and fidelity of evidence based practices, as well as provide consistent statewide communication regarding the advancement of evidence based practices. This committee is a forum for discussion, engagement and the sharing of learnings regarding evidence based practices, with policy makers and practitioners.

In July 2019, the EBP Advisory Committee created a Charter and added two community member positions on the committee. Applicants should have an understanding about the criminal justice system and evidence based practices, have worked or benefitted from the criminal justice system, dedicated to attend and give feedback to the committee, be motivated to work on subcommittees, and provide messaging consistent with committee decisions. The Committee meets every other month on the first Thursday, Department of Corrections Central office from 9 a.m. to noon.
