• ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED BY 10.1.20

1. **QUESTION:** I'm a grant writer working at a Veteran-led 501c3 nonprofit whose President/CEO is a Veteran and whose staff is disproportionately qualified as Veterans. Does this qualify us as a Veteran-owned small business for the purposes of this grant?

ANSWER: In order to qualify as a veteran-owned business, you must be certified by either the Office of State Procurement, or the US CVE, then you are required to submit a Veteran's Preference form (and related documentation) with your response to the RFP. An example of this form is an attachment to this addendum.

Eligible veteran-owned small businesses must be either certified as such by the Office of State Procurement or currently verified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs' Center for Veterans Enterprise (US CVE) prior to the solicitation opening date and time to receive the preference. 2. **QUESTION:** We are interested in the RFP and are wondering about our eligibility as a faith-based organization.

Answer: Faith-based organizations are eligible and encouraged to submit a response to this RFP.

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STATE OF MINNESOTA VETERAN-OWNED PREFERENCE FORM

Unless a greater preference is applicable and allowed by law, in accordance with Minn. Stat. §16C.16, subd. 6a, the State will award a 6% preference on State procurement to certified small businesses that are majority owned and operated by veterans.

Veteran-Owned Preference Requirements - See Minn. Stat. § 16C.19(d):

1) The business has been certified by the Office of Equity in Procurement as being a veteran-owned or servicedisabled veteran-owned small business.

or

2) The principal place of business is in Minnesota AND the United States Department of Veterans Affairs verifies the business as being a veteran-owned or service-disabled veteran-owned small business under Public Law 109-461 and Code of Federal Regulations, title 38, part 74 (Supported By Documentation).

Statutory requirements and appropriate documentation must be met by the solicitation response due date and time to be awarded the veteran-owned preference.
