



Outpatient Programs

Substance use disorder outpatient programs (also known as OP's) are direct treatment services for people with substance use or co-occurring disorders. We welcome participants who are new to the treatment experience as well as those who have been to treatment before. Some outpatient participants are stepping down from a more intensive level of care, while others are just beginning in an outpatient program.

Outpatient treatment offers more flexibility than intensive treatment and allows participants to maintain work, family, and personal commitments. Participants can attend sessions in the mornings or evenings and are able to pursue their personal recovery goals without explanation of a prolonged absence. Our goal is to stabilize mental, emotional, and physical health and equip the participant with the knowledge, skills, and resources necessary to live a life in recovery.



Assessing treatment options and a treatment provider for yourself or a loved one can be overwhelming. Our team of professionals will gather information and help you navigate the process- including assessments, referrals and obtaining approval from insurance or public funding. Length of time in treatment depends on a variety of circumstances that are unique to the individual, however most clients remain in programming for 12 to 20 weeks. Once in our program, our clinical professionals will perform on-going assessments and provide referrals for additional service as needed.

Clients participate in group therapy, while working on an individualized treatment plan. Treatment is supported by a multi-disciplinary team including LADC's, Mental Health Therapists (if needed), Peer Recovery Specialists and Case Workers.

Programming

- ✦ Outpatient Programming is held at 3 locations: Roseville (PM), Hibbing (AM/PM), and Virginia (AM/PM)
- ✦ Program Duration: 12-20 weeks
- ✦ Progress in a particular level of care, rather than a predetermined length of stay, determines an individual's movement through the treatment continuum.
- ✦ Programming utilizes evidence-based curriculum.
- ✦ Access to mental health services, as needed.

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Peer Recovery

Partners In Recovery provides every participant with a Certified Peer Recovery Support Specialist who ensures you are never alone in your treatment journey. A Peer Recovery Specialist is someone who has experienced addiction and has experienced recovery. Peer Recovery Specialists provide an additional layer of emotional support and orient a participant forward in practical and sustainable behaviors.

Admissions

Partners In Recovery has a dedicated admissions team who will guide a client through the process. Same-day and walk-in assessments are available. An assessment can be conducted in person, via phone or telehealth. Based on the information gathered a level of use is identified, discussed with the individual, and an appropriate level of care is recommended. If Partners In Recovery recommends services with another provider, the chemical health assessment will be sent to them, no additional assessment is required to begin treatment.
