Classes are instructor led with an emphasis on structured hands-on activities as well as out of class assignments. To receive CompTIA A+ Certification candidates must pass *Essentials* and *Practical Applications* exams which are provided.

*\*\*Prospective students should have at least 6 months of work experience in IT, or a college degree or certification in IT. You should be able to fully understand:*

Self-support skills with Windows based personal computers - ability to install and run programs - move, copy, delete and rename files in Windows Explorer - knowledge of hardware and software - functions of operating system, applications, and file systems - functions of a computer network - ability to independently assemble a personal computer.
