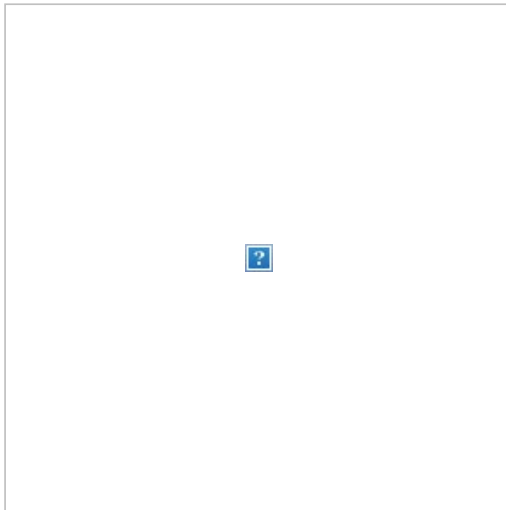

Under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act, making your digital documents accessible isn't just best practice — it's required. 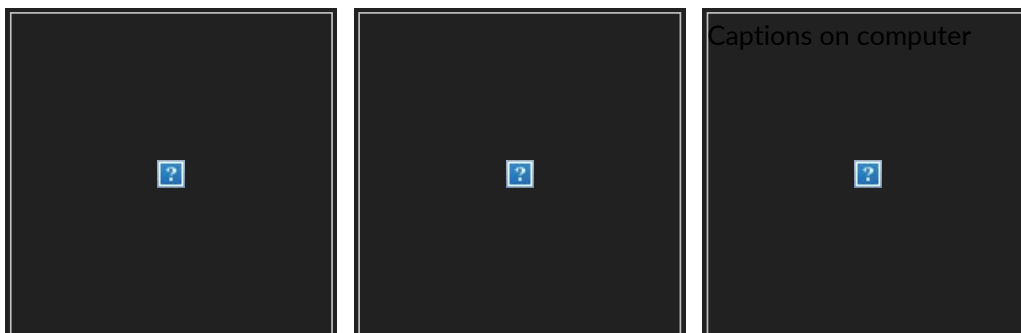
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
