Law enforcement, fire and rescue, emergency medical services, public works, transportation, towing and other responders put their lives at risk when clearing crashes, stalled vehicles or roadway debris. Crash Responder Safety Week (CRSW), which takes place November 13 – 17, aims to educate drivers about the Move Over law and the simple steps everyone can take to keep responders and the public safe when an incident occurs on our roadways.

CRSW not only promotes awareness of the <u>Ted Foss Move Over Law</u>, but it's also a time to encourage traffic incident responders to take part in <u>Traffic Incident Management (TIM) Responder Training</u>. Drivers can make a big difference through their vigilance, but training is also a critical part of the effort to save lives. Efficient response requires seamless collaboration and coordination among responders to meet the needs of those injured, ensure the safety of responders and road users, quickly clear the incident and prevent secondary crashes.
