Proclamation

- WHEREAS:** Officer Felicia Reilly dedicated 17 years of service to the Saint Paul Police Department; and
- WHEREAS:** In 2013, Officer Reilly retired due to serious injuries sustained from a physical assault in 2010 while responding to a 911 call; and
- WHEREAS:** Reilly started her law enforcement career as the first female civilian jailer in Dakota County; and
- WHEREAS:** As a police officer in Saint Paul, Reilly was a faithful servant of the city, with details in the Central District and Vice Unit, spending her last years on Saint Paul's East Side; and
- WHEREAS:** A dedicated officer, Reilly answered the call to serve and protect; she was deeply respected by her family, friends, and colleagues and is remembered for her compassion, devotion to public service, and ability to inspire; and
- WHEREAS:** Reilly died on Saturday, March 1, 2025, as a result of injuries sustained in the line of duty in 2010; and
- WHEREAS:** With its deepest gratitude, the State of Minnesota recognizes Officer Felicia Reilly for her dedicated service to, and sacrifice for, people in Minnesota, and our thoughts and prayers are with her family, friends, and community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags to be flown at half-staff at all state buildings in the State of Minnesota, from sunrise until sunset on Monday, March 10, 2025, in honor and remembrance of Officer Felicia Reilly.
