# Proclamation

WHEREAS: Firefighter Timothy Bertz honorably served the State of Minnesota and the communities of Harris, Lino Lakes, and Saint Paul, dedicating his life to public service; and

WHEREAS: Firefighter Bertz served his country as a United States Navy SEAL before beginning his firefighting career in 2017 with the Harris Fire Department, where he was Harris Firefighter #15 and quickly became a valued member of the department; and

WHEREAS: During his time at Harris, he also served as a duty crew firefighter with the Lino Lakes Fire Department, and most recently fulfilled a lifelong dream by graduating from the Saint Paul Fire Academy and joining the Saint Paul Fire Department; and

WHEREAS: Although his career in the Saint Paul Fire Department was brief, Firefighter Bertz made a profound impact through his discipline, leadership, dedication, and commitment to serving others with integrity and humility; and

WHEREAS: Firefighter Bertz tragically passed away on Monday, December 22, 2025, following a serious medical event, leaving behind his wife, Andrea, family, friends, and countless brothers and sisters in the fire service; and

WHEREAS: Firefighter Bertz exemplified selflessness and courage in life, including choosing to donate his organs so that others may live, a final testament to his dedication to service; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota mourns the loss of a devoted public servant whose life and service made a lasting impact on the communities he served.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags to be flown at half-staff at all state buildings in the State of Minnesota, from sunrise to sunset on Monday, December 29, 2025, in honor and remembrance of Timothy Bertz.
