Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Sergeant First Class Nicole M. Amor, age 39, of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, was killed on March 1, 2026, in Port Shuaiba, Kuwait, during an unmanned aircraft system attack while serving our nation overseas; and
- WHEREAS: Sergeant First Class Amor was assigned to Headquarters and Headquarters Company 103rd Sustainment Command (Expeditionary), an Army Reserve unit based in Des Moines, Iowa, and was serving in support of U.S. military operations in the Middle East; and
- WHEREAS: Sergeant First Class Amor enlisted in the Minnesota National Guard in 2005 and transferred to the United States Army Reserve in 2006, serving more than two decades with dedication and distinction, including prior deployments to Kuwait and Iraq in 2019; and
- WHEREAS: As an Automated Logistics Specialist, Sergeant First Class Amor played a critical role in ensuring that service members received the food, fuel, equipment, and supplies necessary to carry out their missions; and
- WHEREAS: Sergeant First Class Amor was a devoted wife to her husband, Joey, and a loving mother to her two children, and leaves behind family, friends, fellow service members, and the community of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, whose hearts grieve the loss of a devoted spouse, parent, and citizen; and
- WHEREAS: She was known as a special light in her family and community; an avid gardener who found joy in growing peppers to make salsa with her son, who enjoyed rollerblading and bicycling with her daughter, and who showed strength, humor, and compassion to all who knew her; and
- WHEREAS: Sergeant First Class Amor exemplified the highest ideals of service, courage, and selflessness, both in uniform and in her daily life; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes the profound impact of Sergeant First Class Amor's life and service and honors her legacy and sacrifice, standing in support of her family, fellow service members, and the entire White Bear Lake community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags to be flown at half-staff at all state buildings in the State of Minnesota immediately, until sunset on day of interment, in honor and remembrance of Sergeant First Class Nicole M. Amor.
