Dear Commissioner Jacobson,

As part of the budget process for the upcoming budget session, I am writing to seek information about agency expenditures. Given the projected \$5.1 billion deficit for 2028-2029, it's imperative that work begin now to rein in spending and find savings to reduce or close entirely that budget gap and ensure that we are spending Minnesotans' hard-earned tax dollars responsibly.

On or before Monday, January 6, I am requesting the following information:

- 1. The current work from home or remote work policy (or policies if it varies) for agency staff.
- 2. Approximately how many employees, if any, are working remotely from out-of-state.
- 3. An approximate percentage or number of employees who are fully remote and do not have <u>any</u> required or designated in-office days.
- 4. In your agency's largest office space, please provide an estimated percentage or number of employees in the office five days per week.
- 5. Titles and salaries for any FTE position related to diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI). Note: This request does not seek any identifying information about specific employees; I am simply looking for a count and salaries for any/all job titles with those key words included.
- 6. Total number of FTE positions that have been unfilled for six months or longer.
- 7. Total number of FTE positions newly authorized during the 2023-2024 biennium that have been unfilled for any period of time.

Considering the looming \$5.1 billion deficit, I am also requesting that you immediately begin reviewing potential areas for cost savings, efficiencies, or reductions. It is my expectation that the administration will be a partner in working to begin closing that deficit.

You may provide responses to these requests in portions as they become available or all at once, but I expect a response no later than Monday, January 6. Please follow-up with my office if you need additional clarity to assist with fulfillment of these requests.
