

Promoting the Community Needs Survey

The Council on LGBTQIA2S+ Minnesotans (MNQT) is conducting a comprehensive community needs assessment, including a statewide community needs survey. This survey is an opportunity for LGBTQIA2S+ individuals 18 and older and parents/caregivers of LGBTQIA2S+ youth to share experiences, challenges, and priorities to help shape policies, programs, and advocacy efforts in Minnesota. The Council is made up of staff, 12 Governor-appointed public voting members, and 4 legislators and is a non-partisan state agency created to advise the Governor, legislature, and state agencies on LGBTQIA2S+ issues in Minnesota.

About the Survey

Purpose: The Community Needs Survey is designed to identify the needs of and challenges facing LGBTQIA2S+ communities. The goal of the project is to use the data to create policy, administrative, and funding recommendations for the Governor, state legislature, and state agencies. Respondents will be asked about health, legal challenges, education, community support, and more.

Who Should Take It: This survey is for LGBTQIA2S+ individuals 18 and older and parents/caregivers of LGBTQIA2S+ youth.

How to Access the Survey: The survey can be found online at <u>mnqt.info/survey</u>. There will also be paper copies and a secure drop box available at Queermunity beginning sometime early April (3036 Hennepin Ave, Minneapolis, MN 55408).

How Responses Will Be Used: The data from this survey will be used by the Council on LGBTQIA2S+ Minnesotans to identify community needs, inform policy recommendations, and

advocate for resources that support LGBTQ+ individuals across Minnesota. Results will be made available to the public and able to be used by other organizations.

Privacy and Security: The survey is anonymous and confidential. Survey responses are being managed by a team of independent data experts with legal protections that will allow them to remove any potentially identifiable information from individual responses. This will prevent that information from being accessed by anyone else, including MNQT, other state agencies, or the public. To further protect privacy, the survey does not collect identifying information such as name or email, and demographic data is limited to prevent any individual from being identified. Key Messaging and Talking Points

Elevator Pitch: The survey is a critical opportunity to make sure LGBTQIA2S+ voices are heard by the state of Minnesota and community partners. This survey helps identify the challenges, priorities, and needs of LGBTQIA2S+ individuals across Minnesota, guiding advocacy for increased resources and better protections in Minnesota. By taking and sharing the survey, you're helping shape a future where our communities are better supported and represented.

Partners and promoters should:

- Emphasize that the survey is confidential and anonymous, reassuring people their responses will not be traced back to them.
- Highlight inclusivity as a goal, stressing the importance of hearing from underrepresented voices in the LGBTQIA2S+ community.
- Amplify the importance of needing updated, Minnesota-specific data to accurately understand and support the community's needs.
- Share that the survey is a way for community to directly influence policy and funding decisions in Minnesota.

Key Messages:

- Make Your Voice Count This survey is a chance for LGBTQIA2S+ Minnesotans to share their experiences and needs. Your input will help shape the future of policies, funding, and resources that directly impact our communities.
 - o More plain language option: Insights from the survey will shape recommendations to state leaders about what LGBTQIA2S+ communities need to feel safe and supported.

- Every story matters LGBTQIA2S+ people in Minnesota are diverse in identity, background, and experience. Whether you live in a city or in Greater Minnesota, are out or not, your voice is important.
- **Data drives change -** Decision-makers rely on data to fund programs, create policies, and provide services. Without strong LGBTQIA2S+ data, our community's needs can be overlooked. This survey helps make sure that doesn't happen
- Safe, confidential, and anonymous Your privacy is our priority. This survey is confidential and anonymous. Responses are securely managed by a team of independent data experts with legal protections in place, ensuring no one else can access your individual responses.
- **Worth your time** The survey takes about 15-30 minutes to complete, but the insights gathered will help shape policies, funding, and resources that support LGBTQIA2S+ communities for years to come. Your time makes a difference.
- The time to act is now LGBTQIA2S+ communities—especially trans and nonbinary people—are facing heightened attacks, legislative rollbacks, and misinformation. Now more than ever, we need accurate data to push back, advocate for protections, and ensure Minnesota is a place where LGBTQIA2S+ people are supported, safe, and valued.

• Who is running the survey?

The LGBTQIA2S+ Community Needs Survey is being conducted by the Council on LGBTQIA2S+ Minnesotans (MNQT) in partnership with community organizations across the state. MNQT is a state agency that advises the governor, legislature, and state agencies on issues impacting LGBTQIA2S+ communities. It works to advance equity through policy recommendations, advocacy, and research that reflect the needs and priorities of LGBTQIA2S+ Minnesotans. This survey ensures government policies, programs, and funding decisions are informed by the lived experiences of LGBTQIA2S+ people in Minnesota.

Why should I take it?

 Your voice matters, and this survey is a chance to make sure the needs and experiences of LGBTQIA2S+ Minnesotans are heard. Decision-makers rely on data to shape policies, funding, and programs, and without strong LGBTQIA2S+ data, our communities can be overlooked. By taking the survey, you're helping to build a clearer picture of what's needed to create lasting, meaningful change.

• Is it anonymous?

Yes, the survey is anonymous and confidential. Survey responses are being managed by a team of independent data experts with legal protections that will allow them to remove any potentially identifiable information from individual responses. What happens with the data?

 The data will be analyzed to identify key trends and needs within LGBTQIA2S+ communities in Minnesota. This information will be used to inform policymakers, community organizations, and advocates to improve programs, funding, and policies.
 Only aggregated, anonymous data will be shared—individual responses will never be made public.

How will results be shared?

 The findings will be shared through a public report that will be available online and distributed to community organizations, policymakers, and advocates. Key insights will also be shared via presentations, social media, and community discussions to ensure the information reaches the people who need it most.
