Updates from FHV Evaluation Unit

- **Version changes to MIECHV forms application and data collection forms**
 - Recently sent out to MIECHV forms application users – new version of application has correction of one question on 24-month form
 - See last section of “Instructions” document for change log for both application and paper forms

Draft Questions for Immunization FHV Evaluation Measure

Immunization Measure

Feedback Received

- **Decide on what time points to measure**
- **“Up-to-date” needs clear definition**
- **Need flexibility on where to get information**
 - MIIC (available and used by many programs)
 - Parent report (because not all immunizations recorded in MIIC)
- **Mixed on collecting reasons a child is not immunized or up-to-date on shots**

Proposed Measures

- **Of 3/6/12 month children served by FHV, what percentage are up-to-date on their immunizations**
 - “up-to-date” defined as having had all immunizations recommended by the child’s provider
 - This measure is descriptive of the population served by FHV (can be compared with statewide info)

Proposed Measures

- **Of children who were not up-to-date on immunizations at 3/6 months, what percentage are caught up at 6/12 months?**
 - This measure can be used to illustrate one way that home visitors benefit children's health
