Job Summary

This is a benefit-eligible temporary position with an expected end date of 7/31/2024.

This posting will be used to fill six (6) vacancies. One (1) position will be in St. Paul/ Minneapolis metro area and five (5) positions will be located in regions across the state of Minnesota.

Each of the positions must live within the region served. Travel to St. Paul and other meeting or community locations is required.

- Central
- North West
- South East/South Central
- South West/West Central

These positions will organize, build, and maintain regional health equity networks. These networks will bring together partners including Local Public Health, Tribal Public Health, community partners, and others to support an equitable response to COVID-19 and build the capacity of the public health system to advance health equity. Regional coordinators along with network members will identify existing health equity efforts, identify how new relationships and connections could strengthen existing efforts, and facilitate those connections.

These positions will also increase capabilities of network members by:

- sharing regional equity data that can help target public health activities
- coordinating training, coaching and technical assistance with MDH staff and community partners
- identifying and advancing systems changes needed to support health equity efforts
- participating in RFP development

These positions and the resources will support equitable public health approaches by leveraging existing work and making changes in programmatic approaches and organizational policies.

These positions will work to ensure that all communities experience equitable benefits from public health efforts and that there is a consistent commitment to advancing health and racial equity across the public health system.
