The best part? If you shared your cell phone number when you were tested, we'll text you to let you know you can take the survey!

We'll ask you for an email address and send the survey link directly to your inbox.

You can take your time filling out the survey.

The survey link is active for three days.

The information you provide is very helpful to public health workers so they can monitor what is happening with COVID-19.

You will also receive important information on how to reduce the risk of passing COVID-19 to others.

The health department takes your privacy very seriously.

We will never ask you for money, banking information, or your Social Security Number.
