### **What is being proposed?**

The city continues to receive significant interest in providing additional courts for the rapidly growing sport. The tennis courts at Reich Park are scheduled for new asphalt and coatings to be installed in 2024. These courts have been identified as an option for the inclusion of pickleball. Several options exist including keeping the courts as tennis-only, total court retrofit for pickleball only, rearrangement of the lines to facilitate pickleball and tennis or separate courts for tennis and pickleball.

### **Will there be future meetings?**

There are no future neighborhood meetings planned. City staff will review information gathered at this meeting and prepare recommendations for the Park Board and City Council to consider.
