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Project details

The city street that abuts your property is scheduled for rehabilitation beginning this summer. The street has reached a point where city engineers have deemed it necessary to perform significant surface repairs, including the replacement of concrete curbing.

No Parking signs will be placed in your neighborhood two days prior to work beginning and additional details may be found at the link below.

Pre-phase

Sections of concrete curbing are removed and replaced. Yards and landscaping will be restored after concrete has cured.

Phase one

Road is milled down approximately 1.5 inches along the curb line. If there are drainage issues, they will be reviewed in this phase.

Phase two

Manholes and gate vales are raised to accommodate the new asphalt.

Phase three

A new layer of asphalt is applied to the existing roadway.

Will I be assessed?

No. The City of Minnetonka does not assess for these improvements.

Access to property?

Access to driveways will be maintained. No parking signs will be placed along the street in areas crews will be working in.

The only exception to access will be if concrete curbing is replaced at your driveway, which would require your driveway to be closed for approximately two to three days allowing for the concrete to cure. You will be notified in advance if your driveway access will be impacted by curbing replacement.

Please follow construction signs and drive carefully through construction areas.

What do I need to do?

- Move vehicles off of the street
- Keep garbage/recycling bins on the driveway
- Move portable basketball nets off of the street
- Report any problems or concerns about your street.
