

COVID-19 Update, January 13

The following information has been reported to the Metropolitan Council's Employee Resource Center. For privacy reasons, the identities of employees who test positive for COVID-19 cannot be disclosed.

- Based on guidance from the Minnesota Department of Health, individuals who have been identified as having been in close contact with co-workers who test positive for COVID-19 will be notified.
- Close contacts who are fully vaccinated and are not experiencing symptoms do not need to isolate. They should monitor symptoms for 14 days from exposure and get tested immediately if symptoms start.
- Close contacts who are not fully vaccinated (regardless of symptoms) as well as a close contact who has been vaccinated but is experiencing symptoms must isolate for 14 days from exposure.
