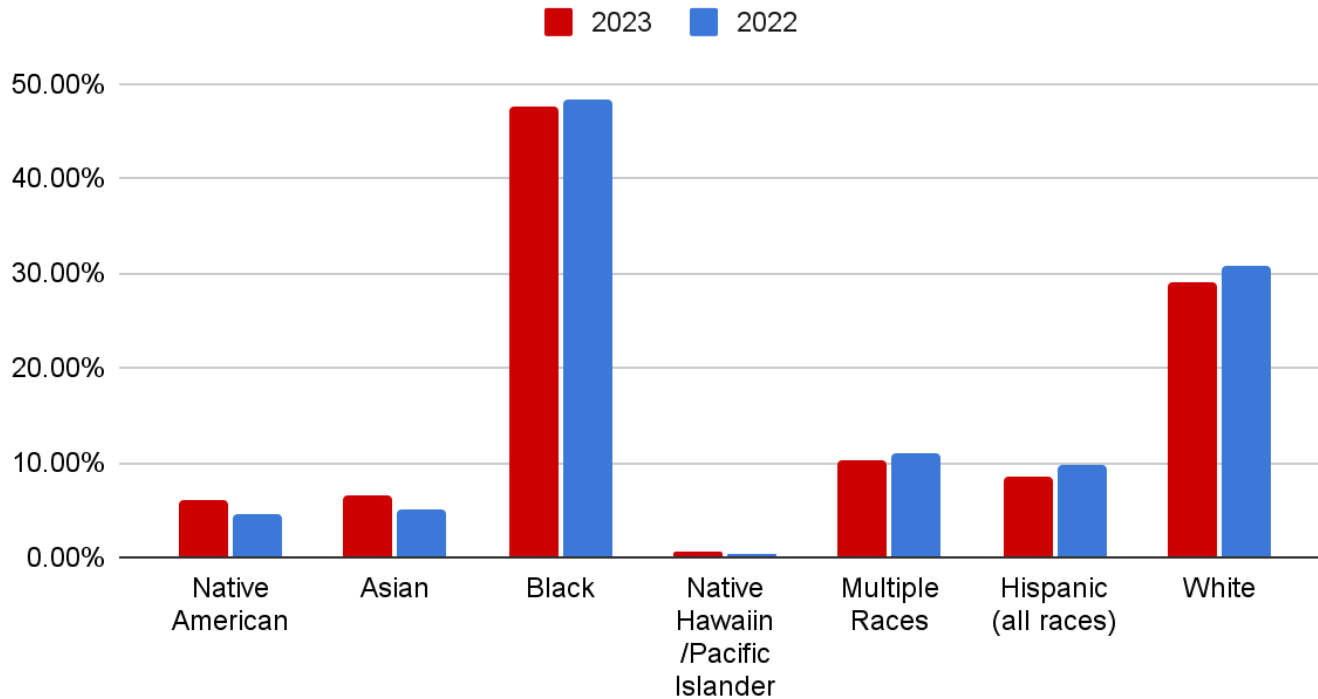

# 2023 Point-in-Time

## Summary:

- Total PIT reduced by 33 people or 1.93%
- Adult only households were reduced by 164 people or 13.23%
- Adult and child households saw an increase of 126 people or 27.69%
- Veteran households increased by 34 people or 46.58%

## Takeaways:

- Something we're doing for single adults, primarily those who identify as Black or White, of all genders is working to move people out of homelessness.
- The inflow of people experiencing homelessness between January 2022 and January 2023 was primarily comprised of Indigenous and Asian people, as well as families, unaccompanied youth under 18, and veterans.
