Community Connect is an event designed for people experiencing homelessness or economic hardship. It will be held on October 23rd and 30th from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM at the Damiano Center, which is located at 206 W 4th Street in Duluth. The purpose of the event is to provide people who are struggling economically with essential hygiene items and winter coats, hats, and gloves.

Community Connect is based on the national Project Homeless Connect, which began in San Francisco in 2004 and has since spread around the country. Community Connect is organized by a coalition of nonprofits including Loaves and Fishes, The Salvation Army, and the Damiano Center, with support from St. Louis County Public Health and Human Services. These organizations will offer information at the event.
