This new, full-time position includes dual roles as director of the flagship El Sistema-inspired afterschool Performance Choir (grades 4-8th) and organizational leadership responsibilities. These include managing budget and program staff and building relationships with various stakeholders. The Music Director will collaborate with the Founder & Executive Director and report to the CMC Board of Directors. This is a renewable two-year contract.

Job Responsibilities

- Lead daily rehearsals and monthly performances (including high profile venues)
- Collaborate with Executive Director to set artistic vision for the year
- Oversee and maintain health of CMC programs (i.e. in-school programs, site-based programs, and CMC Performance Choir)
- Select a diverse body of repertoire for the Performance Choir and teach from a culturally sensitive and informed perspective
- Pursue greater understanding of youth development and facilitate musical learning experiences that focus on cultivating "youth choice and youth voice"
- Create intentional objectives for each song that outline the musical, social, and cross-cultural learning goals
- Design practice tools, benchmarks, assessments and awards that measure and encourage student growth/success
- Actively seek out performance opportunities and/or collaborations in both immediate neighborhoods and beyond
- Oversee performance logistics/scheduling
- Attend board meetings and lead staff meetings
- Supervise Operations Manager, Accompanist, and other hourly teaching artists
- Be an ambassador to CMC in the community and connect regularly with families
- Actively recruit with partner schools and community organizations
- Manage organization budget
- Assist Executive Director in grantwriting and attend fundraising events
- Other duties as assigned
