



# 4-H Campus Immersion Counselor

## Position Description 2021

We are looking for 4 eager college students to join our Campus Immersion Counselor team! Campus Immersion is a 5-day experience (June 21-25) for youth to build their personal pathway and achieve their aspirations for higher education.



### Counselors will:

- Guide, counsel, and supervise campers through the day-camp experience
- Support youth in imaging themselves as future college students
- Develop leadership, social, and responsibility skills
- Provide a safe and fun environment for youth through daily activities
- Hold a positive attitude and demonstrate strong initiative to perform counselor duties
- Act as a positive role model through mentorship and building developmental relationships with youth participants

**What to expect:** Approximately 40 middle and high school youth from urban 4-H programs will participate in the day-camp program at the University of Minnesota Twin Cities campus June 21-25. Youth will experience college life by meeting students and faculty, engaging in STEAM learning experiences, taking tours, and enjoying recreational activities. Youth will learn about college life, with the mentorship of counselors, and will begin to make plans for accomplishing their future goals.

**Compensation:** \$500 stipend for the 5 days on campus, as well as mandatory counselor training (1-2 days of training held prior to June 21)

### Qualifications:

- Must have a High School diploma or equivalent, and currently enrolled as an undergraduate college student
- Must complete background check by Campus Immersion start date
- Commitment to diversity/inclusion and mentoring teenagers
- Responsible, friendly, enthusiastic, patient and willing to learn
