Application Selection Process

<p>Who can apply?</p>	<p>Any owner, operator, compliance manager or other leadership representative within a licensed operating facility. To help support clear communication, DCR will require acknowledgement from the Designated Contact that the applicant may represent the licensee on their behalf.</p> <p>Other considerations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only one representative from a license may apply. • Only one representative from a group of licensees linked through common ownership or under common management may apply. • In case of member openings on MCRC, DCR may hold a new application period for new members to complete an existing term. 																																													
<p>What is the time commitment for members?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approximately six virtual meetings per year (1 hour) • No more than two in-person workshops, as needed. • There may be some work between meetings and/or voluntary subgroup meetings for specific topics. • In-person meetings will be in Jefferson City. • 2- year term 																																													
<p>How will you select members?</p>	<p>DCR wants to ensure a diverse workgroup comprising many different business structures including small and large facilities, multiple license holders, stand-alone operators, individuals with a variety of backgrounds and expertise, etc. The collaborative will have representation from all license types and regions across the state with no more than 30 members.</p> <p>Applications will be selected by a committee comprised of the DCR Public Outreach Director, a representative from the DCR Program Development Unit and the Section for Patient and Application Services, and an individual from another DHSS division with experience in reviewing applications.</p>
