Application Selection Process

| Who can apply? | <p>Any owner, operator, compliance manager or other leadership-level representative of a licensed <u>operating</u> facility. Microbusiness licensees must be working towards becoming operational. To help support clear communication, DCR will require acknowledgment from the Designated Contact that the applicant may represent the licensee on their behalf. NOTE: Members who completed the 2024 two-year term are not eligible to apply. However, an individual from the same organization may apply.</p> <p>Other considerations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only one representative from a license may apply. • Only one representative from a group of licensees linked through common ownership or under common management may apply. • In case of member openings on MCRC, DCR may hold a new application period for new members to complete an existing term. | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | |

| How will you select members? | <p>DCR wants to ensure a diverse workgroup comprising a range of business structures, including small and large facilities, multiple license holders, stand-alone operators, and individuals with diverse backgrounds and expertise.
