The Health Insurance Premium Payment Program For MO HealthNet Participants



What is the HIPP Program?

MO HealthNet's Health Insurance Premium Payment (HIPP) Program can help pay for your share of your health insurance premium when it costs less than it would to cover the same services through MO HealthNet. MO HealthNet may also be able to reimburse copays, coinsurance, and deductibles.

If I have MO HealthNet, why would I want health insurance?

There are several reasons having health insurance besides MO HealthNet may be helpful, such as:

- Your health insurance may cover services that MO HealthNet does not
- Other members of your family who are not eligible for MO HealthNet may be able to get coverage through your health insurance plan and the HIPP Program
- You will still have health insurance if you are no longer eligible for MO HealthNet, you will just be responsible for paying the premiums

Who is eligible?

To be eligible for help through the HIPP program, **all** of the following must be true:

- You or a member of your household are eligible for MO HealthNet and have already applied
- You have health insurance coverage available from a current or former employer, a labor union, a credit union, an individual policy, an organization, a church, etc.
- MO HealthNet determined it will cost less to pay your insurance premium than to cover services
