Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Kansas City Chiefs make their proud home in the great State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the people of the great State of Missouri are equally proud of their beloved Kansas City Chiefs; and

WHEREAS, the Chiefs Kingdom has been unfailingly loyal in support of their beloved team; and

WHEREAS, the Chiefs brought the Kingdom something particularly special this year: the Lamar Hunt Trophy, awarded to the American Football Conference (AFC) champion and named for the owner who brought the Chiefs to Kansas City in 1963; and

WHEREAS, the Chiefs brought the Lombardi Trophy to Kansas City once before in 1970, standing on the shoulders of Chiefs legends such as Hank Stram, Lamar Hunt, Fred Williamson, Bobby Bell, and Len Dawson; and

WHEREAS, the Chiefs, led by owner Clark Hunt, head coach Andy Reid, and outstanding players, showed a Missouri-like tenacity by coming back three separate times when down by ten or more points for the first time in National Football League (NFL) playoff history; and

WHEREAS, despite trailing by ten or more points in all three playoffs games, the Chiefs never gave up, battled back to victory, and defeated the San Francisco 49ers by a score of 31-20 in Super Bowl LIV in Miami Gardens, Florida.
