Dear Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary LeVine:

Pursuant to the termination provisions of the Agreement Implementing the Relief for Workers Affected by Coronavirus Act (see Paragraph XI), executed on or about March 28, 2020, as amended¹, the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (“Department”) hereby gives notice of intent to terminate effective the week ending June 12, 2021.

Specifically, the Department gives notice of termination for the following programs²:

- Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA);
- Emergency Unemployment Relief for Governmental Entities and Nonprofit Organizations;
- Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC);
- Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC);
- 100 Percent Reimbursement of Short-Time Compensation Benefit Costs Paid Under State Law (STC); and
- Mixed Earner Unemployment Compensation (MEUC).

The Department understands and will comply with its obligations under the Agreement to process all claims filed under these programs, whether or not fully resolved by the week ending June 12, 2021.

¹ Such amendments include the “100 Percent Reimbursement of Short-Time Compensation Benefit Costs Paid Under State Law” addendum to the Relief for Workers Affected by Coronavirus Act, signed on June 5, 2020 and the “Mixed Earner Unemployment Compensation” addendum signed on December 30, 2020.

² As of July 5, 2020, Missouri previously terminated its waiting week waiver (the “Temporary Full Federal Funding Of The First Week Of Compensable Regular Unemployment For States With No Waiting Week” agreement).
