

Girard Ave S. Reconstruction Project



August 5, 2020

The City of Minneapolis is reconstructing Girard Ave S. between Lake St and Lagoon Ave during the 2020 construction season. The project consists of removing and replacing the street pavement and utilities, replacing the sidewalk, and adding new green features between Lake St. and Lagoon Ave. The new Girard Ave will be curbsless, which will prioritize people's ability to walk comfortably to, from, and along Girard Ave S. The street will consist of a single flat surface without curbs to allow for flexible and accessible future uses.

During construction, the street will be closed to through traffic. Local access will be maintained. The roadway work is anticipated to be substantially complete by the end of 2020, with landscaping likely occurring in the spring of 2021.

Latest Project News

Pavement is currently being installed on the south end of Girard Ave and will continue in the coming week. Work on the rain garden beds is nearing completion, with plant installation to follow at a later date.

The sidewalk on the south side of Lake St is complete, including the new pedestrian bump out. Sidewalk installation continues on the north side of Lake St.

Lane restrictions remain in place on Lake St as well as on Girard Ave.



What's Coming Up

Concrete crews will continue pouring pavement for the roadway on the south half of Girard Ave.

Intersection work at Lake St and Girard Ave is ongoing, and work at this intersection will continue through August.

Once the south half of Girard Ave is complete, crews will shift to the north half of the block.

The project team continues to monitor traffic along this corridor and adjust as needed.
