

WILLIAM BERRY PARKWAY & RICHFIELD ROAD Intersection Improvements

Public Works will be making improvements to the William Berry Parkway/Richfield Road intersection in August-September 2022. The improvements will include rebuilding the traffic signal and replacing the pedestrian and bicycle ramps to improve accessibility.

The new signal will have a pedestrian scramble, which is a type of signal treatment that stops all traffic and allows people to cross from all corners at the same time—including diagonally. Pedestrian scrambles allow people to cross the street without any vehicle movements through the intersection. Drivers will see red signal indications during the pedestrian scramble, so potential conflicts between pedestrians and vehicles are eliminated.
