Man killed in shooting.

December 19, 2023 (Minneapolis): At approximately 6:35 on Tuesday evening, Minneapolis Police Department officers from the 4th Precinct responded to reports of a shooting on the 900 block of Newton Ave. N. At the scene, officers found a man suffering from an apparent life-threatening gunshot wound. First responders preformed life-saving measures, but despite all efforts, the man did not survive his injuries.

On-scene investigators believed the suspects were hiding in a nearby abandon house. MPD SWAT searched the abandoned residence and found it to be empty.

Investigators are working to determine the circumstances surrounding the shooting. There have been no arrests.

The GO number is 23-336480.

Forensic scientists from the Minneapolis Police Forensic Division responded to process the scene and collect evidence. Homicide detectives responded to begin an investigation.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner will release the victim's name along with the cause and nature of the death.
