Minneapolis Police are investigating a double shooting that resulted one injured and one dead.

September 1, 2024 (MINNEAPOLIS) On August 31st, 2024, at approximately 10:47 p.m., Fifth Precinct Officers responded to a shooting on the 2900 block of Grand Av S. Officers located a man in his 20s outside with life-threatening gunshot wounds. Officers provided immediate medical aid until EMS arrived. Despite all life-saving efforts, the man died at the scene. Officers also identified a man in his 20s with at least one apparent non-life-threatening gunshot wound. He was transported by ambulance to Hennepin Healthcare.

Preliminary information indicates that the deceased and injured men were part of a group walking on the sidewalk when shots were fired. Possible suspects were seen leaving the scene on foot.

Officers secured the scene and canvassed the area.

MPD Forensic Scientists responded to process the scene.

Investigators are working to determine the circumstances that led up to the shooting.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner will release the deceased man's name along with the cause and manner of death.
