Minneapolis Police are investigating an early morning homicide.

November 23, 2024 (MINNEAPOLIS) Minneapolis Police Chief Brian O'Hara announced that an early morning shooting on the 2400 block of 17 Av S has resulted in a homicide.

At approximately 4:45 a.m., 911 callers reported hearing three gunshots and seeing a man down in the middle of the street. Officers from the 3rd Precinct located a man in his late 20s with life threatening gunshot wounds. They provided immediate medical aid including the application of a tourniquet. That man was transported to Hennepin Healthcare Hospital. Despite all life saving efforts, the man died at the hospital.

MPD is working to determine the sequence of events that led up to the shooting.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner will release the identity of the man along with the cause and manner of his death.

"This is a tragic event that occurred in a neighborhood near a park and a church," said Chief O'Hara. "Our investigators will work diligently to determine what occurred this morning. We need anyone with information about what happened to contact us immediately."
