**WHO:** Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED and be authorized to work in the U.S.

**WHEN:** Monday, Wednesday, Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.  
Begins Monday, March 10, 2025

**COST:** There is no cost. Participants are paid \$17.05/hour
