Minneapolis Police Investigating Overnight Homicide

December 20, 2024 (MINNEAPOLIS) Minneapolis Police Chief Brian O'Hara said that a man has died after being shot overnight.

On December 19, 2024, at approximately 10:59 p.m., officers from the 4th Precinct responded to a ShotSpotter Activation in the 3500 block of Penn Ave N. When officers arrived, they found a man with a life-threatening gunshot wound. Officers immediately began lifesaving aid including CPR. The man was transported by EMS to North Memorial Medical Center where he died.

MPD homicide investigators responded to the scene to begin determining the sequence of events that led up to the shooting.

"My thoughts are with the victim's family," said Chief O'Hara. "This man's loved ones will be dealing with an incredible loss during the holiday season. I urge anyone who may know information about what happened to contact our investigators."

Minneapolis Forensic Scientists responded to process the scene.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner will release the identity of the deceased individual along with the cause and manner of death.
