MPD Officers Arrest Two after Saturday Shooting

February 1, 2025 (MINNEAPOLIS) Minneapolis Police Chief Brian O'Hara said two are in custody after a Saturday shooting thanks to the efforts of responding officers.

On February 1, 2025, at approximately 12:36pm, Third Precinct Officers responded to the area of 22 Av S/Franklin Av to reports of a shooting. Officers found a man with an apparent non-life-threatening gunshot wound. He was transported by EMS to Hennepin Healthcare Hospital.

Preliminary information indicates the man was inside of an apartment with two known individuals. During a narcotics transaction, the man was shot by one of the individuals. He left the apartment and called 911.

Officers located the apartment in the 2000 block of 21 Av S. When officers arrived, there was no one inside the apartment. Officers began gathering information about the two individuals who had been inside the apartment. They relayed this information to other officers who were able to locate the two individuals getting on a bus several miles away. They were both arrested without incident.

"Gun violence has no place in our city, and we will relentlessly pursue those who commit violent crimes," said Chief O'Hara. "I am grateful for the swift, coordinated efforts of our officers, whose dedication and persistence led to the immediate arrests of those responsible. Their work exemplifies the relentless commitment of the Minneapolis Police Department to ensuring justice for victims and removing dangerous criminals from our streets. We will continue to use every resource available to combat crime and violence and protect the people of Minneapolis."

Investigators are working to determine the sequence of events around the incident.
