Man Dies at Hospital after Shooting, MPD Investigating

July 26, 2025 (MINNEAPOLIS) – Minneapolis Police Chief Brian O’Hara announced today that MPD is investigating a shooting that occurred early morning where one man was killed.

Just before 1:00 a.m., Third Precinct officers responded to a shooting near 24 Street E and 18 Avenue S. Officers located a man in his 20s suffering from at least one life-threatening gunshot wound. Officers rendered immediate medical aid. He was transported by EMS to Hennepin Healthcare Hospital, where he later died.

Preliminary information indicates that a verbal argument escalated to gunfire. The alleged shooter fled the scene.

MPD is investigating to determine the sequence of events that led up to the shooting.

“Gun violence has claimed another life, devastated another family, and further traumatized a community,” said Chief O’Hara. “Anyone with information about this tragedy is urged to come forward as we work to understand what happened and identify ways to prevent further violence.”

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner’s Office will release the name of the deceased man along with the official cause and manner of death.

No arrests have been made.
