Minneapolis Police are investigating the shooting death of a man.

February 25, 2026 (MINNEAPOLIS) – Minneapolis Police Chief Brian O’Hara announced that a man was shot and killed inside an apartment building in south Minneapolis.

At approximately 10:42 p.m. on February 24, Fifth Precinct officers responded to a report of a shooting inside an apartment building on the 100 block of E. 18th St. Officers located an adult man with a fatal gunshot wound lying in a first-floor common area of the building.

Preliminary information indicates that an altercation escalated to gunfire.

Officers secured the scene and canvassed the building and surrounding area. MPD investigators are working to determine the sequence of events that led to the shooting. MPD Forensic Scientists responded to process the scene and collect evidence.

There have been no arrests.

“Another life has been lost to senseless gun violence,” said Chief O’Hara. “We are asking anyone with information about this incident or the identity of those involved to come forward and assist investigators.”
