### **Minneapolis Police investigating after man killed in overnight shooting**

**March 14, 2026 (MINNEAPOLIS)** –Minneapolis Police Chief Brian O’Hara announced the investigation of an overnight shooting that left one man dead.

At approximately 1:30 a.m. on March 14, 2026, Fifth Precinct Officers responded to a shooting that occurred on the 2300 block of Hennepin Ave S. Officers arrived and located a man with at least one life-threatening gunshot wound. Officers provided medical aid including CPR. The man was transported by ambulance to Hennepin Healthcare where he later died.

Preliminary information indicates the man was in a parking lot with a group of people when gunfire erupted from outside the group and struck him.

Investigators are working to determine the sequence of events that led to this violence. Minneapolis Forensic Scientists responded to process the scene.

There have been no arrests

“Gun violence devastates families and traumatizes communities, and tonight it took the life of a man,” said Chief O’Hara. “We will do everything we can to bring those responsible for this senseless violence to justice.”
