Minneapolis Police investigating crash that killed a bicyclist

April 20, 2026 (MINNEAPOLIS) — Chief O'Hara announced that a bicyclist has died after being struck by a vehicle. The driver has been arrested and booked.

At approximately 3 a.m., Third Precinct officers responded to the intersection of Hiawatha Avenue and East 35th Street on a report of a crash involving a bicyclist. Officers located an unconscious man in his 50s with apparent life-threatening injuries lying in the roadway and provided immediate medical aid, including CPR. The man was transported to Hennepin Healthcare, where he later died.

Preliminary information indicates that Diallo Greer, 23, was driving south on Hiawatha Avenue in a Ford Edge when he struck the bicyclist near East 35th Street.

Officers placed Greer into custody and transported him to Hennepin Healthcare, where a search warrant for evidence collection was carried out. He was later booked into the Hennepin County Jail on suspicion of criminal vehicular homicide. He is also suspected of driving under the influence.

Minneapolis Police Forensic Scientists and an MPD Traffic investigator processed the scene and collected evidence.

MPD investigators are working to determine the sequence of events that led to the crash.

The MPD incident number is 26-100762.
