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Minneapolis Police investigating a shooting death.

May 25, 2026 (MINNEAPOLIS) — Chief O'Hara announced that a man died after being shot.

At approximately 12:18 a.m., Third Precinct officers responded to multiple reports of shots fired near the 4100 block of Columbus Ave S.

Officers arrived and located a man in the street with life-threatening gunshot wounds. Officers moved the injured man to the area of 42nd St E and Columbus Ave S to provide medical aid. Despite all lifesaving efforts, the man died at the scene.

Officers secured the scene and canvassed the area. Evidence of gunfire was located along the 4100 block of Columbus Ave S.

MPD Forensic Scientists processed the scene and collected evidence.

MPD homicide investigators are working to determine the full sequence of events that led to the shooting. There have been no arrests.
