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Public Information Release

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Minneapolis Police investigating an early morning shooting that injured nine adults.

July 19, 2026 (MINNEAPOLIS) — The Minneapolis Police Department is investigating a multiple-person shooting that occurred outside the Reign Event Center on the 2900 block of Hennepin Ave.

The following preliminary information is subject to change.

At approximately 12:27 a.m., Fifth Precinct officers responded to the report of a shooting with multiple people injured. The first officers arrived in less than one minute. Due to the number of victims and the large crowd outside, additional officers were requested. Officers from all five precincts, along with officers working the Chief's Beats, responded to assist.

Officers located four injured people at the scene: a 20-year-old man with potentially life-threatening gunshot wounds; a 21-year-old man, a 22-year-old woman, and a 27-year-old woman, each with apparent non-life-threatening gunshot wounds. All four were transported by ambulance to Hennepin Healthcare.

An 18-year-old man later walked into Hennepin Healthcare with an apparent non-life-threatening gunshot wound.

Four additional injured people arrived at Abbott Northwestern Hospital: a 20-year-old man, a 21-year-old man, and a 22-year-old man with apparent non-life-threatening gunshot wounds, and a 21-year-old man with potentially life-threatening gunshot wounds. The man with potentially life-threatening gunshot wounds was later transferred by ambulance to Hennepin Healthcare.

Preliminary information indicates gunfire erupted outside the event center following a reported altercation. A large crowd was present at the time of the shooting. Investigators are examining whether gunfire was fired from a vehicle.

Officers secured the scene and canvassed the area.

MPD Forensic Scientists processed the scene and collected evidence.

Firearm Assault Shoot Team (FAST) investigators are working to determine the sequence of events that led to the shooting.

There have been no arrests.
