Daniel M. Guzynski and Caitlin Creighton, Assistant Attorneys General and Special Deputy Lake County Attorneys, allege that the above-named Defendant, MATTHEW TIMM, has committed the following offenses in Lake County, Montana:

Count I: SEXUAL ABUSE OF CHILDREN, a felony, as specified in Mont. Code Ann. § 45-5-625(1)(b):

On or about or between January 1, 2017, and March 31, 2023, the Defendant committed the offense of SEXUAL ABUSE OF CHILDREN by knowingly photographing, filming, videotaping, or recording a child under the age of 18 engaging in sexual conduct.

This offense is punishable by the provisions of Mont. Code Ann. § 45-5-625(2)(a), by imprisonment in the Montana

State Prison for life or a term not to exceed 100 years, a fine not to exceed \$10,000, or both.

Count II: INCEST, a felony, as specified in Mont. Code Ann. § 45-5-507:

On or about or between January 1, 2017, and September 1, 2019, the Defendant committed the offense of INCEST by knowingly having sexual contact with a descendant. At the time of the offense, the Defendant was four or more years older than the victim and the victim was less than 18 years old.

This offense is punishable by the provisions of Mont. Code Ann. § 45-5-507(3), by imprisonment in the Montana State Prison for life or a term not to exceed 100 years, or a fine not to exceed \$50,000.
