The NCDPI will pay the one-time assessment fee of \$15.00 per conference registrant. Conference participations will not be able to take the electronic assessment after the October 11 deadline, nor will they be able to take the assessment during the conference.

General Session Prep - Strengths Finder Assessment

This year, conference attendees will be participating in an interactive skill assessment activity. The first general session speaker (Stosh Walsh) will talk about the "Strengths Finder" and what your individual strengths mean for your unique kind of leadership. In preparation for this session we are asking that you complete the "Strengths Finder's" Interactive Assessment. The link for the assessment will be sent to conference registrants within 2-3 days following registration. Each assessment will be confidential and will be known only to the individual participant. IMPORTANT NOTE: This is a timed assessment; therefore, individuals should prepare to complete it when the chance of interruption is minimal. Please complete the evaluation by October 11, 2016.

We are again offering the School Nutrition Specialist (SNS) Exam as a pre-conference session to provide you with the opportunity to obtain this credential from the School Nutrition Association (SNA). SNA established the SNS Credentialing Program in 1997 to enhance the professional image of school nutrition professionals, elevate professional standards and enhance individual performance. The SNS Credential is a mark of excellence and achievement that reflects what it takes to manage school nutrition programs in today's challenging climate. The

SNS Credentialing Exam evaluates candidates' knowledge and skills required to perform specific job activities related to managing or directing school nutrition programs.

SNA's School Nutrition Specialist (SNS) Credentialing program is governed by the Certificate and Credentialing Governing Council, an autonomous arm of the School Nutrition Association. The Governing Council members and SNA Credentialing Program Staff are solely responsible for the policies and administration of SNA's Credentialing program.

The exam will be administered on October 26, 2016 at 8:00 AM in room Empire D at the Sheraton Imperial Hotel and Convention Center, 4700 Emperor Blvd, Durham, NC 27703 (Research Triangle Park).
