LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

December 21, 2016

There has been a winter flurry of Special Sessions between last week and this week with education legislation every day. As of this afternoon during the 2016 Fifth Extra Session, the House and Senate re-convened to consider the repeal of HB 2 Public Facilities Privacy & Security Act (<u>SL 2016-3</u>) from the 2016 Second Extra Session. Additionally, in these last two weeks there has been relevant education legislation:

Passed

- 1. HB 2 Disaster Recovery Act of 2016 (SL 2016-124)
 This law grants relief in the wake of Hurricane Matthew and the wildfires in the western part of the state. Among other things, it "forgives" all but two of the school days missed. For the exact provision, see Section 5.7 of the law, entitled "Flexibility in School Calendar to Accommodate Extraordinary Circumstances."
- 2. HB 17 Modify Certain Appts/Employment (SL 2016-126)
 Governor McCrory signed this bill into law this week. The State Board of Education (SBE) had its own special called meeting on Tuesday to analyze this bill and review the constitutional implications of the legislation. SBE plans to convene another meeting to decide how to proceed.

- 3. HB 13 Class Size Requirement Changes
