RE: New Resources – Special Education Surrogate Parent (SESP) Training Materials

The Exceptional Children Division is pleased to provide local education agencies (LEAs) two online training modules for identifying, training and maintaining surrogate parent volunteers.

The first training module, <u>SESP Guidance Module</u>, provides the information necessary to coordinate a special education surrogate parent volunteer program. It provides an overview for LEA staff who are involved in determining when a surrogate parent is needed as well as assigning and training surrogate parent volunteers.

The second training module, <u>SESP Volunteer Module</u>, can be used when training volunteers on the rights and responsibilities of being a surrogate parent. It also provides a brief overview of the special education process.

Both modules are videos with accompanying transcripts. The guidance manual also includes a section that can be used as a handbook for surrogate parent volunteers and sample forms to help the LEA in implementing procedures.
