Explicit instruction is an evidence-based direct approach to teaching that includes both instructional design and delivery. It is characterized by a series of scaffolds where students are supported throughout the learning of a new skill until reaching independent mastery. It is a critical component of specially designed instruction for students with disabilities and for intensive intervention for all students.
