## **RE: INTERPRETER/TRANSLITERATOR GUIDELINES**

These guidelines are to help clarify the role of educational interpreters/transliterators in schools and to improve the professional's knowledge and skill and ensure students with hearing loss who require an interpreter or transliterator as a related service, accommodation or supplemental aid or service, can access the curriculum and the total school environment in accordance with FAPE.
